QCPR Module 1

Longer-term positioning of the UN development system in the post-2015 development landscape

This module would discuss the challenges and opportunities posed by the 2030 Development Agenda; explain the opportunities that the QCPR process offers to Member States to guide, assess and monitor UN operational activities for development in the very first years of implementation of the 2030 Agenda; and present options discussed during the ECOSOC Dialogue and explore their implications for the next QCPR.

QCPR Module 2

Functions of the UN development system

This module would focus on the functions of the UNDS in the post-2015 world, to deliver on the ambitions of the universal and integrated nature of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The module would explore the new development landscape and the increasingly diverse capacities and needs of countries, e.g. HICs, MICs, LDCs, conflict-affected countries and SIDS, requiring a repositioning of the UNDS to provide the necessary targeted and tailored support. In this regard, the module would also explore the implications of the required post-2015 functions on organizational arrangements, capacity, impact and partnership approaches.
