Free movement of people within EEU BUT : Migrants across EU faling through a gap between...

- a) ENTREPRENEURSHIP POLICY: those responsible for economic and business development
 - = opinion : entrepreneurship is primarly the reserve of the more educated and technologically advanced members of the society
- b) EMPLOYEMENT POLICIES: Those concerned with social inclusion and employement
 - = feel that the way to combat exclusion is through employment

Short overview actual projects

1. BRYO:

Idea of a scientist, engineer or IT specialist.. Assist that idea result in a product or project that the market can conquer. Special approach for newly arrived people... (Special agreements with countries like India, Spain, Greece,... for STEM professions to bring over to Flanders)

2. STEM – Academy: Target group 8-16

Special approach for children (8-16) of migrant & newly arrived/diaspora...

3. Senior Entrepreneurship

People +50 (Migrants!) with technical background within outplacement procedure helping to set up an own business/enterprise

4. Linking Nationalities

Adapted measures in company level for better employability for technical skilled migrants with low or non knowledge of the language

5. Job channel

- specific approach for migrants with low knowledge of Dutch
- knowledge acquired elsewhere (SERV databank with +500 job descriptions)

6. Ethnic Minorities Entrepreneurial Platform

Migrants that in collaboration with local entities create a platform in cities as knowledge and information exchange centers

7. TalentPOOL

employing 45 + seasonal workers amongst ethnic minorities in various sectors based on their talents, knowledge, dexterity

8. ERASMUS for Young Entrepreneurs

Idea for setting up actions for young starters with foreign background (have advantage of knowledge of culture in own country...)

9. Workplace training with sector: providing up to date training
