REACHING OUT TO A VARIETY OF STAKEHOLDERS THROUGH E-LEARNING

- 3424 online participants have enrolled in the free introductory courses on the 2030 Agenda and the SDGs:
- 486 UNITAR certificates were issued.
- 94% of respondents applied or transferred the acquired knowledge.

PROMOTING ROBUST MONITORING AND EVIDENCE-BASED DECISION MAKING

- StaTact toolkit, an action-oriented tactical tool was developed to improve data governance and dialogue between data producers, data users and nontraditional data sources:
- 15 countries most of them Least Developed Countries – successfully piloted the StaTact tool;
- More than 180 participants from governments and other stakeholders participated in pilot workshops.
- 85% of responding participants felt their knowledge, skills and attitudes (KSA) have increased as a result of the workshops.



SUPPORTING UN MEMBER STATES IN THE HOLISTIC AND INCLUSIVE IMPLEMENTATIN OF THE SDGS

- 46 VNR countries presenting at 2017-2019 HLPF and many other Member States benefitted from e-learning for SDG coordinating entities on stakeholder engagement and the SDGs;
- 228 government officials and national stakeholders participated in learning conferences on holistic implementation of the SDGs;



ENHANCING MULTIPLIER EFFECTS

- 33 African and Asian LDCs and 1 SIDS benefited from UNITAR open-source toolkits in 2017-2018 enabling them to facilitate national training and multistakeholder workshops;
- 171 HLPF participants have benefitted from SDGs learning as part of the joint UNITAR-UNDESA Learning, Training and Practice Centre.
