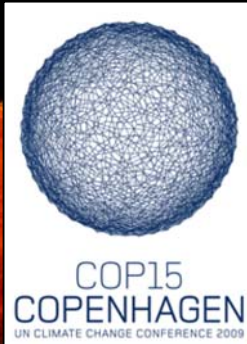


## EXECUTIVE WORKSHOP
