Background

 November 2023: Global Framework on Chemicals – For a planet free of harm from chemicals and waste (GFC) adopted

- GFC contains Target B6:
 - By 2030, all Governments have implemented the Globally Harmonized System for Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) in all relevant sectors as appropriate for their national circumstances






ICCA's role in promoting implementation

- Believe the GHS is the foundation of a strong chemicals management system
 - In partnership with EU, UNITAR, ECHA, UNEP, SACIM: funded the 'GHS in Africa' Pilot Project
- ICCA is supportive of the GFC and its goals
 - Continue to demonstrate our commitment to implementation through this project




GHS Implementation Globally

Role of UNSCEGHS in GHS Implementation

- The GHS Subcommittee is responsible for maintaining the GHS, promoting its implementation, and providing additional guidance as needs arise.
- GHS Subcommittee has the following functions:
 - Act as custodian of the GHS
 - Keep the GHS up to date as necessary
 - Promote understanding and use of the GHS and encourage feedback
 - Make the GHS available for worldwide use and application
 - Make guidance available on the application of the GHS and the interpretation and use of technical criteria
 - Prepare work programmes and submit recommendations to the committee
