Executive Diploma on International Criminal Law and Transitional Justice

This executive diploma is designed to provide unique access to information, perspectives, updates and analysis on accountability mechanisms for both those seeking to develop a working background on the topics as well as those already thoroughly versed in their dynamics.

During the five-week substantive program conducted online, participants from around the world will listen to analysts, academics, policy makers and international experts to gain insight and rare first-hand knowledge about different accountability mechanisms from a wide range of perspectives. The substantive sessions will explore specific areas, such as the notion of mass human rights violations, as well as the history, development and achievements of different accountability mechanisms.

In addition to e-workshops, modules focused on skills will provide participants with a holistic training experience and allow them to put their substantive knowledge into practice.

Executive Diploma on Law and Neuroscience

Partners: The Center for Law, Brain & Behavior (CLBB) at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH)

Maastricht University (MU), with faculty affiliated with Harvard Medical School, Harvard Law School, Stanford Medical School.

This course introduces participants to the interdisciplinary field of law and neuroscience (in short: neurolaw). It aims to explore current applications, as well as some challenges and limitations, of implementing neuroscientific research and neurotechnology in the legal system. Special emphasis will be placed on criminal law applications.

During the five-week online programme, participants from around the world will hear from international experts to gain insight and rare first-hand knowledge about law and neuroscience from a wide range of perspectives.

By using a comparative approach, considering both U.S. and European jurisdictions, participants will understand how neuroscientific research may inform criminal justice doctrine, practice, and policy.
