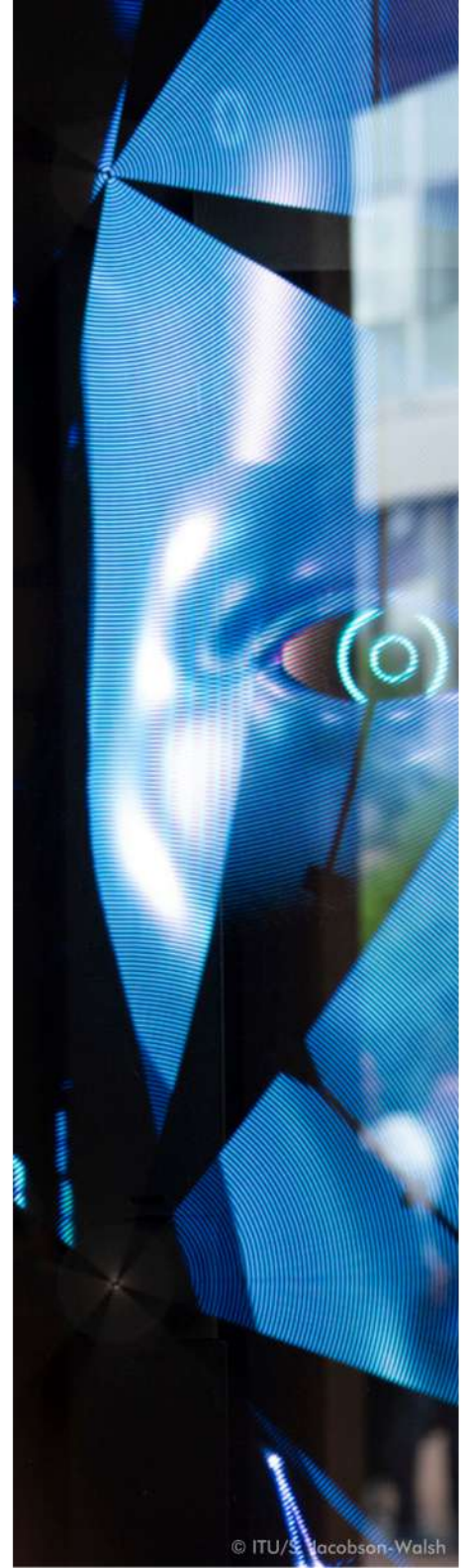

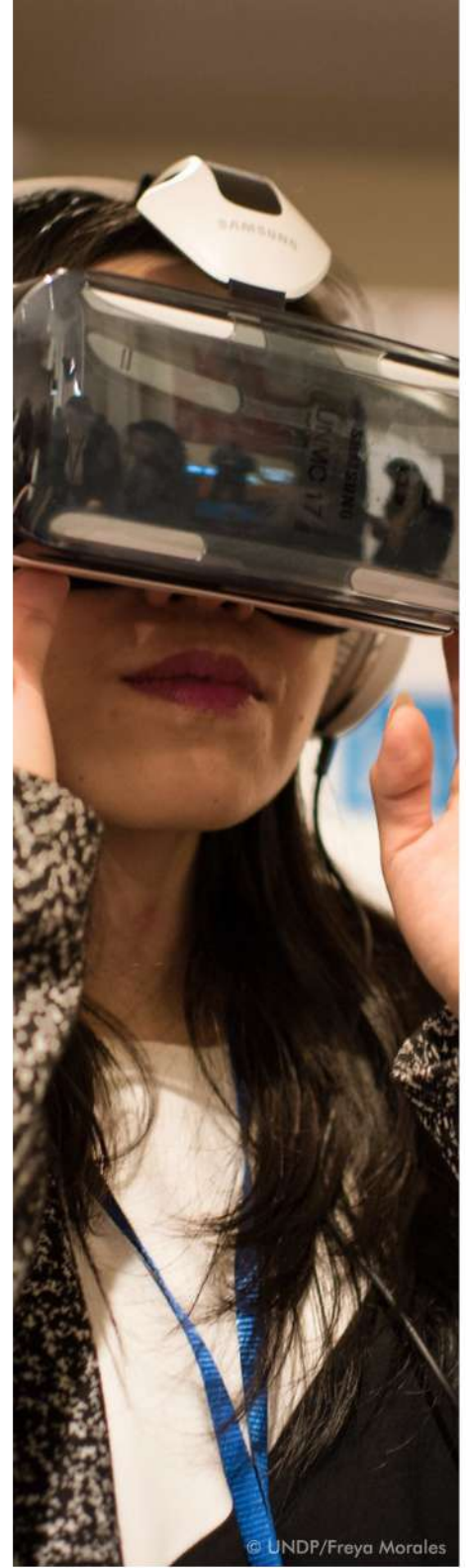
Customised Trainings

UNITAR was founded in 1963 based on the recommendation of the UN Economic and Social Council to the General Assembly. The Secretary-General then established the United Nations Institute for Training and Research, as an autonomous body within the UN system.



1968

UNITAR expanded its training activities under the leadership of Chief S.O. Adebó of Nigeria, including the establishment of regional training seminars to train junior diplomats from the Global South, and the launch of fellowship programmes.
