

ARRIVING | BY PLANE

Bonn can be reached through three international airports: Cologne/Bonn Airport, Düsseldorf Airport and Frankfurt Main Airport.

FROM COLOGNE/BONN AIRPORT

AIRPORT EXPRESS SB 60

CONVENIENT TRANSPORTATION TO BONN CENTRAL STATION

The Airport Express SB 60 offers a direct route from the departure terminal at Cologne/Bonn Airport to Bonn Central Station and back. Operating regularly, it provides a hassle-free journey for both arrivals and departures.

SCHEDULE AND DURATION

On weekdays, the Airport Express SB 60 operates every 30 minutes between Bonn and the airport. During Saturdays and Sundays, the schedule varies, with departures every 30 or 60 minutes. The bus journey covers a distance of 25 km and takes approximately 27 minutes when traveling to the airport. The return trip to Bonn lasts around 32 minutes.

FROM COLOGNE/BONN AIRPORT

AIRPORT EXPRESS SB 60

TICKET INFORMATION

One-way tickets for the Airport Express SB 60 cost €7.70. Some airlines offer a combined ticket that includes both the flight and bus fare. The bus, accommodating 42 passengers, provides onboard storage for baggage. Tickets can be conveniently purchased from the bus driver.

CITY TICKET BENEFIT

Your Airport Express ticket can also serve as a "City ticket," allowing you to use Bonn's bus or tram services to reach your final destination. Ensure you validate your ticket at the red validation machine when boarding a bus or tram in Bonn.

STOP AND TERMINAL INFORMATION

At the airport, the Airport Express SB 60 has one designated stop located at Terminal 1. For additional information, including detailed timetables, please refer to [insert link].

TAXI OPTION

Should you prefer a taxi, clear signage at Cologne/Bonn Airport guides you to the taxi stand just outside the terminal. The approximate taxi fare from the airport to Bonn is €40.00.

FROM DÜSSELDORF AIRPORT

SKY TRAIN (H-BAHN) AND TRAIN CONNECTION TO BONN (HBF)

To reach Bonn from Düsseldorf Airport efficiently, follow these steps:

1. SKY TRAIN TO DÜSSELDORF FLUGHAFEN TRAIN STATION:

Board the Sky Train for a short 10-minute journey to Düsseldorf Flughafen train station

2. DIRECT TRAINS TO BONN HAUPTBAHNHOF:

From Düsseldorf Flughafen, you can catch direct trains to Bonn main station, known as "Hauptbahnhof Bonn." These trains operate hourly throughout the day.

3. ALTERNATIVE ROUTE VIA DÜSSELDORF HAUPTBAHNHOF:

If you prefer additional options, consider taking a train to Düsseldorf main train station, "Düsseldorf Hauptbahnhof." From there, more frequent trains are available to Bonn main train station.

FROM FRANKFURT AIRPORT

TRAIN TRAVEL

To reach Bonn from Frankfurt Airport efficiently, follow these steps:

1. GO TO FERNB TO FERN

Upon arrival at Frankfurt Airport, follow the signs leading to "Fernbahnhof," the train station for long-distance trains. Note: While within the airport, the train station is approximately a 10-minute walk.

2. CHOOSING YOUR TRAIN:

Attendees are recommended to opt for either the high-speed Inter City Express (ICE) train to Bonn/Siegburg Bahnhof or Intercity (IC)/Eurocity (EC) trains to Bonn Hauptbahnhof.

2.1. TRAINS DEPARTURES:

Trains depart from Frankfurt Airport long-distance train station two to three times every hour, operating between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m.

2.2. HIGH-SPEED ICE TRAIN AND U-BAHN TO BONN/SIEGBURG

- The high-speed ICE train journey to Siegburg/Bonn takes about 40 minutes, with at least one departure per hour.
- U-Bahn No. 66 to Bonn Hauptbahnhof, from Siegburg to Bonn. This tram runs every 20 minutes and takes approximately 25 minutes. Confirm whether your Deutsche Bahn ticket includes this city ride.

2.3. IC/EC TRAIN TO BONN HAUPTBAHNHOF

- The IC/EC train travels directly to Bonn main station in the center of Bonn.
- Travel time ranges between 1.5 and 2 hours.

2.4 TICKET INFORMATION

- Second-class tickets for the Inter City Express (ICE) cost around €60 one way, and for the Intercity (IC) around €40.
- The ICE train can sometimes be booked in conjunction with your flight.

ARRIVING | BY BUS

FROM BONN CENTRAL BUS STATION (BUSBAHNHOF ZOB)

- Bus Options: No. 610 or 611 (both direction: Heiderhof)
- Platform: C4
- Bus Stop: Deutsche Welle

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Take bus No. 610 or 611 (direction: Heiderhof) from Bonn Central Station (ZOB), departing from platform/bus point C4.
2. The ZOB is situated just across the main train station (Hauptbahnhof).
3. The bus journey takes approximately 10 minutes to reach the bus stop "Deutsche Welle".
4. Upon disembarking, turn left to find Platz der Vereinten Nationen and locate the main gate of the United Nations at the street corner.

FROM BAD GODESBERG

- Bus Options: No. 610 (direction: Duisdorf) or 611 (direction: Lessenich)
- Bus Stop: "Deutsche Welle"

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Take bus No. 610 or 611 from "Rheinallee". The bus stop is positioned just behind the main subway station in Bad Godesberg.
2. Disembark at the "Deutsche Welle" stop; the ride typically takes around 10 minutes.

ARRIVING | BY TAXI

The fare for a taxi to "Langer Eugen" from most places in Bad Godesberg or Bonn city centre should not exceed € 10–15 depending on where you are coming from.
