Peacekeeping

We specialize in preparing uniformed personnel for UN peace operations, emphasizing the significance of training to enhance performance and ensure successful mission implementation. Our capacity building approaches aim to instigate sustainable behavior change, optimise performance, and actively contribute to the priorities of the Action4Peacekeeping+ Initiative.

Peacemaking and conflict prevention

Our commitment to peacemaking and conflict prevention is driven by distinguished flagship initiatives like the Fellowship Programme in Peacemaking and Preventive Diplomacy. This program has successfully imparted knowledge and skills in conflict analysis, negotiation, mediation, and reconciliation for three decades.

Counter-terrorism and preventing/countering violent extremism

Dedicated to supporting governments in establishing self-sufficient institutions for counter-terrorism efforts, we provide training and capacity building solutions. These efforts are geared towards strengthening the operational and strategic capabilities of key entities.

Youth and Women's Empowerment
