Entrepreneurship and Innovation promoting Health Security and Economic development in Iraq, Jordan and Lebanon

"Entrepreneurship and Innovation promoting Health Security and Economic development in Iraq, Jordan and Lebanon" is an entrepreneurship training programme for aspiring and established entrepreneurs, leaders, and members of micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in Iraq, Jordan, and Lebanon. The programme will equip you with the knowledge, skills, and network you need to turn your ideas for a social or for-profit enterprise into a business model that addresses challenges from the COVID-19 pandemic and contribute to building a resilient health sector in the region.

The training programme will run in two phases from July 2023 – March 2024.

The programme will be delivered in English. You will receive a UNITAR certificate of completion if you complete the course and meet minimum criteria.

The programme is free for participants and conducted with the full financial support of the Government and the People of Japan.

Eligibility

The programme is open to motivated entrepreneurs and leaders, **both men and women**, **from Iraq**, **Jordan**, **and Lebanon** who are eager to create and implement innovative local solutions to aid the health industry and the broader private sector. Individuals active in the public health and healthcare fields are particularly urged to apply. In order to apply, you must have:

- Good oral and written English skills
- Access to Internet and a computer or smartphone

UNITAR will review your application for your:

- Keen passion to learn by doing and highly motivated to contribute the healthcare and economic development in Iraq, Jordan, and Lebanon through self-led projects/enterprises
- Deep interest in entrepreneurship and public health
- Commitment to actively participate throughout the entire duration of the program, which might include traveling within and outside the country to partake in face-to-face trainings.
- Age (between 18 and 45)

Programme Structure

The programme will run in three phases:

In **Phase 1**, the digital programme will provide training to 150 individuals from Iraq, Jordan, and Lebanon, focusing on significant subjects in entrepreneurship and public health. The program consists of self-paced online modules, interactive peer discussions, assignments, and expert-led webinars from regional and international experts in the field.

Top-performing participants will progress to **Phase 2** of the programme, where you will further design and prototype your business/projects through in-depth training and mentoring. Top-performing participants from Phase 2 will also be invited for **Phase 3** where they will come together for **an online hackathon or an in-person workshop (To be confirmed).** This phase's activities are subject to change depending on the COVID-19 situation.



The overall course is designed to encourage you to take action across seven areas:

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Nurture an Entrepreneurial

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You will learn to identify opportunities and mobilize resources to bring a new enterprise to life. You will be exposed to examples of social and commercial enterprises and international best practice, and encouraged to reflect on and develop your entrepreneurial style and capacity.

Mindset

Find a Problem WorthSolving

You will learn the tools and techniques of design thinking and lean startup to create desirable, feasible, viable and sustainable solutions that solve social needs and problems. Design thinking focuses on building empathy, identifying needs through customer/citizen insights, ideation, prototyping and experimentation.

Build a Scalable and Sustainable Enterprise

You will learn to design a business model for your enterprise, identify social needs, evaluate revenue and funding models, and formulate financial projections. You will also learn how to pitch to win funding, donations, and investment.

- Employ design-thinking methodologies to pinpoint needs or problems, and devise a project or a venture that addresses the COVID-19 pandemic in a strategic, sustainable, and inclusive manner.
- Demonstrate self-insight, inquisitiveness, strategic thought process, collaboration, and an understanding of societal needs, utilize modern leadership and management techniques and communicate efficiently.
- Encourage equal gender opportunities by leveraging existing potentials and tackling existing obstacles.
- Engage in a conversation about the essential elements of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
