








LEARNING-RELATED BENEFICIARY OUTREACH

Target will be defined in 2023. Therefore not applicable for 2022 figure.


Refers to the percentage of learning-related beneficiaries from events with objective assessment of learning meeting certification of completion requirements according to the UNITAR Certification Policy.

MOOC category, i.e. face-to-face, online events by invitation, etc.






% OUTREACH PARTICIPANTS FROM SPECIAL SITUATION COUNTRIES IN LEARNING EVENTS

Refers to the percentage of participants from LDCs, LLDCs, SIDS participating in events associated with a specific learning outcome. This is a subset of the learning-related beneficiary outreach. The target is based on the 2014-2017 and 2018-2021 strategic objectives to focus programming on meeting needs of beneficiaries most in need. Prior to 2016, UNITAR only tracked the LDC sub-category.




MM GENDER RATIO



From 2015 to 2019, UNITAR tracked the overall ratio as well as the ratio without Peacekeeping Training Programme (PTP) statistics. In 2018 and 2019 participants had the possibility to select "other" genders than male and female and non-binary as of 2022.



% LEARNING OUTCOME EVENTS





% OVERALL USEFULNESS


