





COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



METHODS OF RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Gain a foundation in social science research by exploring key concepts, hypothesis generation, study design, and fieldwork. Develop critical skills to evaluate research in international relations, social sciences, and business contexts.



DIPLOMACY WORKSHOP: PRACTICAL AND HISTORICAL (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Explore the practical aspects of diplomacy, including policy formulation, negotiation, and international treatises. Delve into modern diplomatic challenges like cyber diplomacy, diplomatic transparency, and violence against diplomats, while understanding diplomacy's role in commerce and global relations.



RELATIONS AND DIPLOMACY WORKSHOP (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Address current global topics such as health, climate change, and regional development through a workshop format. Develop dissertation ideas as you work on topics that change each semester, fostering critical thinking and research skills.



CURRENT ISSUES IN INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS: THEORIES (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Examine and apply major international relations theories to current global issues in a seminar format. Explore varying paradigms and their relevance to today's complex international landscape, fostering a deeper understanding of theoretical application.



MEDIA COMMUNICATION STRATEGIES (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Analyze the relationship between media, politics, and society, focusing on media ethics, freedom, and the role of journalism in shaping public opinion. Explore the power of digital media and its impact on political decision-making and democracy.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Critically examine the role of international organizations like the UN, NATO, and the EU in fostering interstate cooperation. Explore how these institutions shape global politics and the challenges they face in maintaining international order.




CONFLICT AND PEACE STRATEGIES (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Investigate the causes of conflict and explore peace-building strategies, including negotiation and mediation. Focus on post-WWII peace strategies and international law's role in addressing violence and humanitarian interventions.



INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC PROBLEMS (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Analyze global economic challenges using theoretical frameworks, focusing on trade, globalization, finance, and income distribution. Explore key issues like poverty, inequality, and their impact on international economic relations.



INTERNATIONAL LAW (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Explore the foundations of public international law, including jurisdictional conflicts, environmental protection, and maritime disputes. Analyze how international legal systems address contemporary issues like investment arbitration and cybercrime legislation.



HUMAN RIGHTS (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)



COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



ADVANCED TOPICS IN INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Focus on current international business issues or institutions chosen by the instructor. Analyze significant conflicts or developments impacting international business in-depth, fostering a nuanced understanding of global business challenges.



MASTER'S THESIS/PROJECT (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Conduct original research in international relations, synthesizing knowledge gained throughout the program. This dissertation or project contributes to the field, demonstrating the ability to apply theoretical concepts to real-world challenges.



FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM AND GRADUATION CEREMONY (STUDY VISIT TO GENEVA)

Participate in a study visit to Geneva, visiting international organizations and attending training at UNITAR. Engage with diplomats and experts, culminating in a prestigious graduation ceremony at the United Nations Office in Geneva.


