WHAT IS THE MA IN GLOBAL SUSTAINABILITY LEADERSHIP?

The MA in Global Sustainability Leadership is a collaborative programme between <u>Technological University</u> <u>Dublin (TU Dublin)</u> and the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR). It is designed to develop leaders who can address sustainability, peacebuilding, and conflict resolution challenges by equipping them with practical skills, academic knowledge, and a global professional network.

The programme offers two flexible study options: a full-time, one-year blended programme, which combines face-to-face modules at TU Dublin with online modules from UNITAR, or a fully online, part-time option over two years. It is designed for professionals, policymakers, and academics seeking to advance their expertise in sustainable development and global leadership while balancing work and study commitments.

WHEN DOES THE PROGRAMME START?

The upcoming cohort of the programme starts in **September 2025**.

WHAT IS THE DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME?

The MA in Global Sustainability Leadership is a 90 ECTS programme designed to equip students with a deep understanding of sustainability, leadership, and innovation.

- <u>Full-time</u> learners complete the curriculum in **one year**, engaging in an intensive study schedule with higher course loads per semester.
- Part-Time learners spread their coursework over two years, offering greater flexibility for working

- Assessments are staggered across the semester to balance workload.

CAN I EXIT WITH A POSTGRADUATE CERTIFICATE?

Yes! You can exit the programme with a Postgraduate Certificate in Global Sustainability Leadership after completing the first year (Semesters 1 and 2).

APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

- Academic Requirements: A minimum second-class honours degree (2.2) or equivalent in any discipline.
- English Proficiency: Non-native speakers must provide proof of English proficiency. Exemptions may apply if previous studies were conducted entirely in English.
