COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



INTRODUCTION TO SUSTAINABILITY (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Explore **sustainability fundamentals**, as well as the historical evolution of the concept, modern-day **global objectives**, and why companies integrate **sustainable practices** into their business operations.



GLOBAL CHALLENGES / NEW BUSINESS MODELS (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Analyze **globalization's impacts** on society and the environment, including **human rights** and **climate change**, using real-world **business case studies**.



REPORTING AND COMMUNICATION (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Learn the essentials of **sustainability reporting** and **transparency**, as well as the risks of inadequate **communication**. Explore key **standards** and practices for effective reporting.



CORPORATE GOVERNANCE / ECONOMIC DIMENSION (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Understand Corporate Governance and the economic aspects of sustainability. Learn to use tools for sustainable performance, and address challenges related to the Green Economy, Degrowth theories, and the Common Good Economy, as well as public policies and international trade.



SUSTAINABLE FINANCE AND INVESTMENT (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Study sustainable finance principles, financial metrics, and investment standards. Learn to attract investors and support sustainability through financial practices.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



SOCIAL DIMENSION (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Focus on stakeholder engagement and social impacts. Address education, cultural heritage, and multiculturalism, taking these into account to achieve equitable sustainable development.



ENVIRONMENTAL DIMENSION (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Examine strategies to combat environmental degradation and resource depletion. Work on projects reducing carbon footprints in sectors like agriculture and textiles.



SUSTAINABILITY MANAGEMENT (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Learn how to manage **Sustainability** within businesses, focusing on **Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)**. Explore essential functions like **Supply Chain Management**, **Human Resources Management**, and **Change Management** to address social and environmental risks effectively.



INTERNSHIP (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Earn the opportunity to complete a **3-6 month** internship in the field of sustainability at the end of your studies. You will need to announce your intention to participate at the beginning of the course, and will undergo a selection process. Both Schiller and UNITAR will support you in your application, including by providing individualized coaching.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



SUSTAINABILITY APPLIED PROJECT (3 SEMESTER CREDITS)

Apply sustainability principles and gain hands-on experience by participating in 1 of 2 applied projects. The first option gives you the opportunity to implement circular economy principles in corporate supply chains with the help of 3-4 classmates. The challenge includes outlining implementation plans and evaluating effectiveness. Alternatively, you can carry out an optional internship and then conduct Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) assessments individually. You will also develop tailored strategies, and assist in ESG implementation planning.



FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM AND GRADUATION CEREMONY (STUDY VISIT TO GENEVA)

During the 1-week study visits, you will have the opportunity to immerse yourself in the very heart of diplomacy. Visit various international organizations and the Palais des Nations (United Nations Office at Geneva), and participate in face-to-face training sessions at UNITAR headquarters delivered by practitioners, academics, and senior diplomats. Network with diplomats, permanent mission personnel, and civil servants. At the end of the study visit, you will have a stunning graduation ceremony and receive certification in line with UNITAR's policy.


