OIOS activities include audit, evaluation and investigations

The purpose of OIOS is to assist the Secretary-General in:

"fulfilling his/her internal oversight responsibilities..."

"in respect of the resources and staff of the Organization..."

"through independent, professional and timely..."

"internal audit, investigation, inspection and evaluation activities"

(A/RES/48/218 B)





OIOS is operationally independent

- Reports directly to the Secretary-General and the General Assembly
- Authority to initiate, carry-out and report on any action it considers necessary to fulfill its oversight responsibilities
- Right to direct and prompt action to all persons engaged in activities under the authority of the Organization
- Right of access to all records, documents, assets and premises as it considers necessary in the conduct of its activities
- The Under-Secretary-General for Internal Oversight is appointed by the Secretary-General, and approved by the Assembly, for a non-renewable term of 5 years.





OIOS covers more than 90 entities

- **UNHQ Secretariat** Departments/Offices
- Offices away from UNHQ: UNOG, UNOV & UNON
- Five regional commissions: ECLAC, ECA, UNESCAP, UNECE, ESCWA
- Peacekeeping and Special Political Missions
- Courts and Tribunals ICJ and IRMCT
- Certain funds & programmes: UNEP, UN-HABITAT, UNHCR, UNJSPF
- MoUs with some other UN System entities







OIOS worldwide locations



OIOS outputs and results in 2021/22

- **481** oversight reports issued:
 - 109 audit
 - 27 inspection and evaluation
 - 345 investigation
- Around half related to peace operations
- OIOS issued 883 recommendations to 46 entities, covering areas of high risk to programme management, information technology and data management, financial management, strategic management, and governance and control










Overall OIOS posts have increased slightly since 2017





- 341 posts across all OIOS (net +5 posts since 2017)
- Most growth in investigations and evaluation:
 - 13 new posts in ID
 - 11 new posts in IED
- Gender balance is improving:42% F: M 58%
- Diversity: 74 nationalities

Programme focus areas for 2022

- (a) implementation of the management, peace and security, and development reforms
- (b) organizational culture
- (c) procurement and supply chain management
- (d) missions in drawdown or transition
- (e) protection against retaliation (whistle-blower protection)
