Płock is located in central Poland, in the Mazowieckie Voivodeship. Its area is 8806 hectares and there are around 120 000 inhabitants.

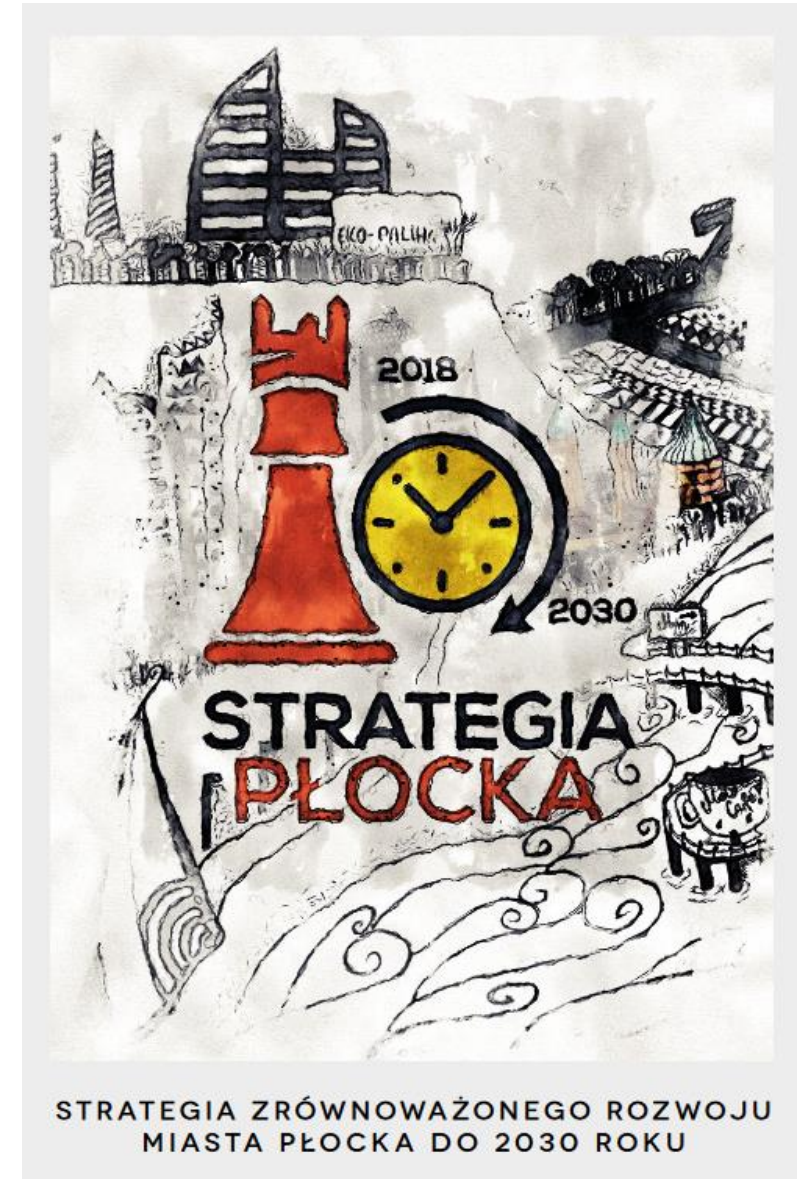

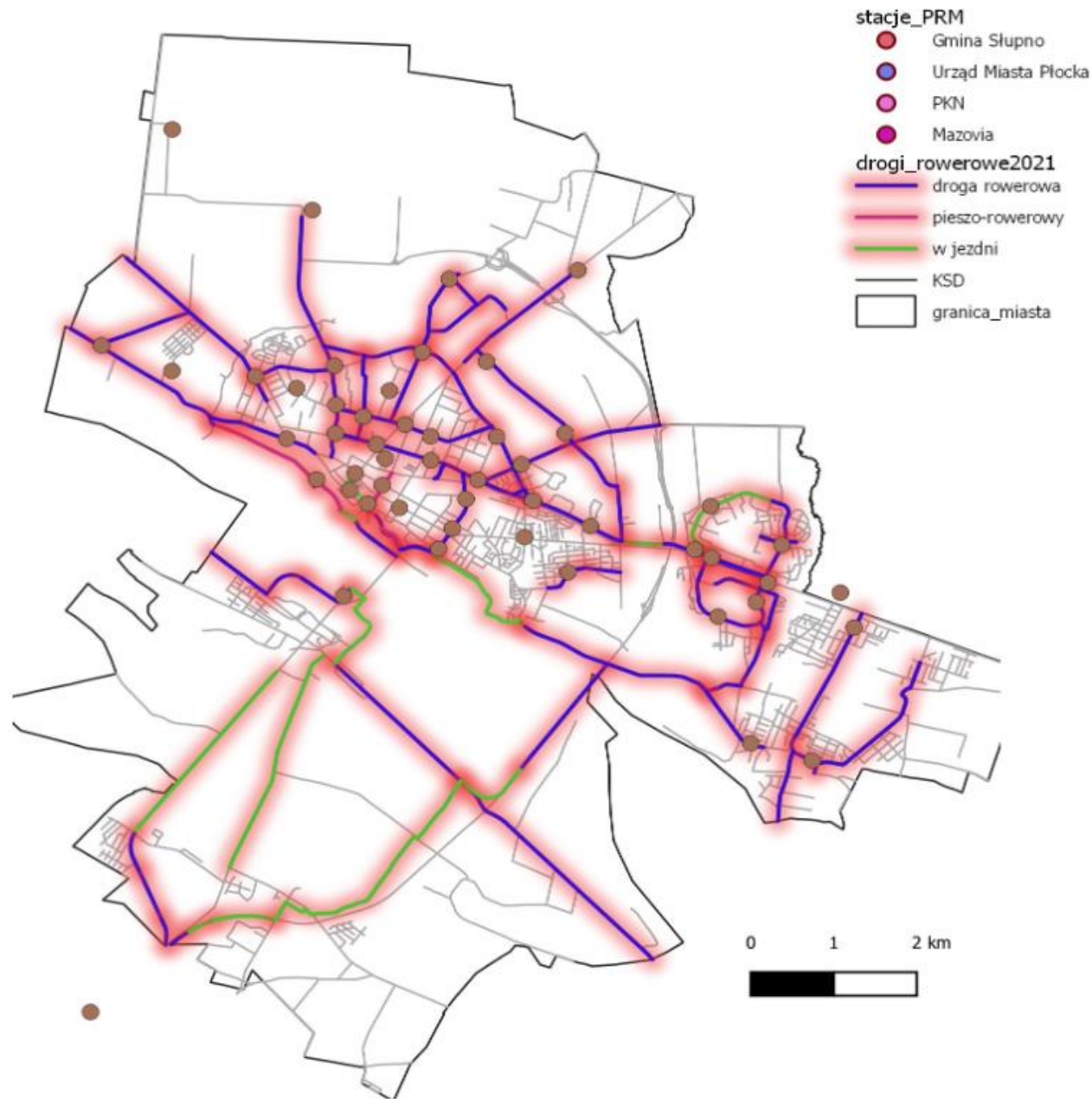

Bicycles and Bicycle Paths System

- Bicycle Paths System- over 70 km bicycle paths
- Płock City Bike – 560 bikes (including 20 with child's seats) for rent in 56 stations
- **Over 37 000 users of the City Bike in 2022!**
- Bicycle stands





Public Transport



- 29 hybrid buses, 814 bus stops
- Bus lanes, electronic boards informing about bus arrival
- **Mobile applications with special functions for public transport users:**
 - **PlocKARTA**- ticket discount for registered users; notifications about tickets and routes
 - **MY BUS** – buses schedule; checking the real-time bus location
 - **Park&Ride Car Parks**





Electric vehicles

- 74 PUBLIC electric vehicles charging points
- 11 electric vehicles owned by the Municipality



The President of Płock signed a letter of intent with the Polish Oil Concern PKN Orlen on cooperation for the development of zero-emission public transport based on hydrogen-powered drives.



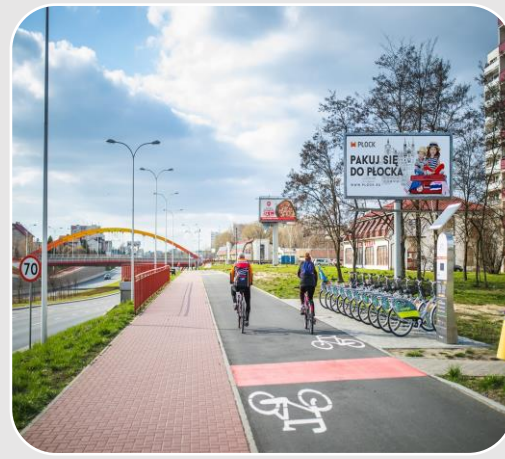
Płock is a beneficiary of the **Clean Hydrogen Partnership** project – the Project Development Assistance support regions in developing hydrogen projects.



Education and Campaigns



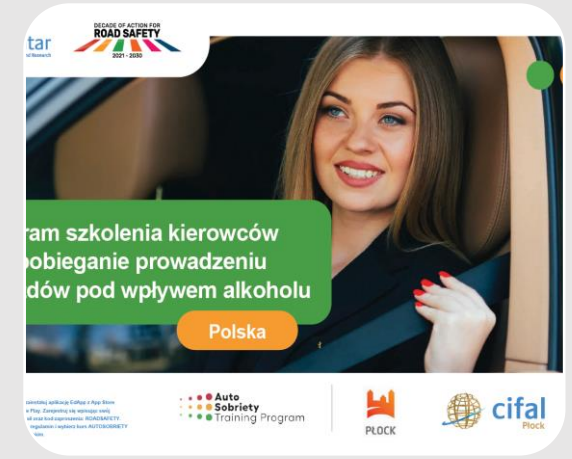
Cycling May – campaign for primary schools encouraging children to cycle to school, collect stamps and win prizes for the class and the whole school.
