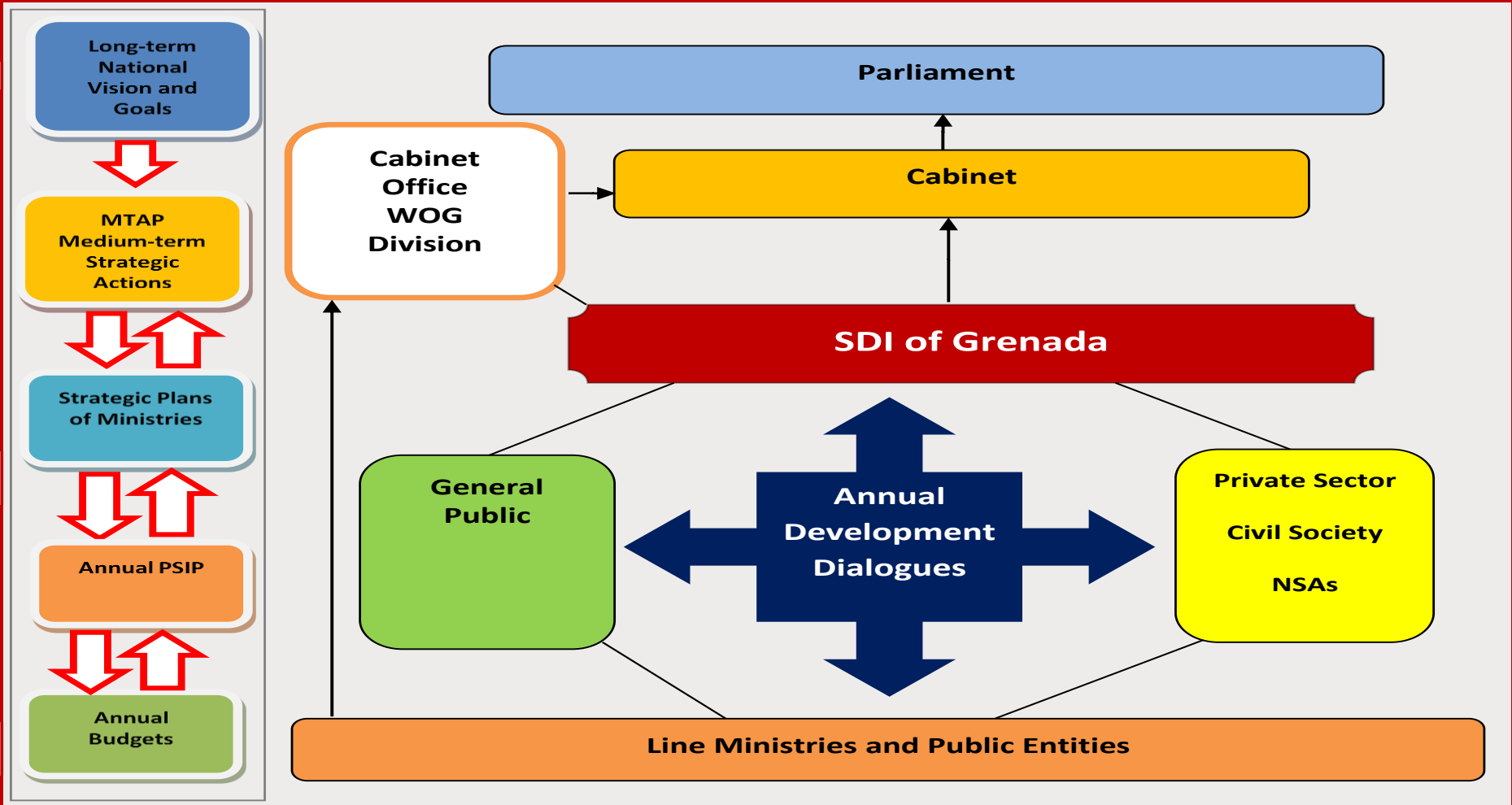
Mandate:

- Dedicated Entity for the Coordination of Grenada's National Sustainable Development Plan 2020-2035.
- Grenada's SDGs Implementation Agency.

Organizational Setup:

- Semi-Autonomous Entity.
- Established by Statute.

Sustainable Development Institute Cont'd



Sustainable Development Legislation

Objectives:

- Establish a framework for the implementation of the National Sustainable Development Plan;
- Establish the National Sustainable Development Institute to coordinate the implementation of the National Sustainable Development Plan; and
- Create a framework for institutionalization of sustainable development principles and practices across the public sector, private sector, civil society organizations and the public.

Sustainable Development Legislation

Cont'd

Key Features:

- Part II contains clauses 4 to 20 and provides for the National Sustainable Development Institute to co-ordinate implementation of the National Sustainable Development Plan through the preparation of Medium-Term Action Plans for implementation.
- Part III contains clauses 21 to 26 and provides for Medium-Term Action Plans to be prepared by the Institute to address implementation of the Plan incrementally and to be approved by the Minister of Finance.
- Clause 22 provides for the public consultation process for discussion of the draft Medium-Term Action Plans.
- Clause 26 provides for the Institute to provide a report on the compliance with the relevant Medium-Term Action Plan by the Government and its agencies.
