- **Goal:** To build sustainable capacities in countries through efficient, effective, and harmonized delivery of statistical training that will enable production and use of quality data and statistics including monitoring and implementation of SDGs.
- Three task teams, including task team 2: Online gateway and e-learning community of practice, established in 2019.
- Members from international agencies, regional training institutes and NSOs who provide guidance beyond own borders
- Stakeholder advisory group: NSOs from 12 countries who provide input and guidance on priorities for GIST

- The IAEG-SDGs secretariat has since reached out to custodian agencies asking them to add their materials to the platform.

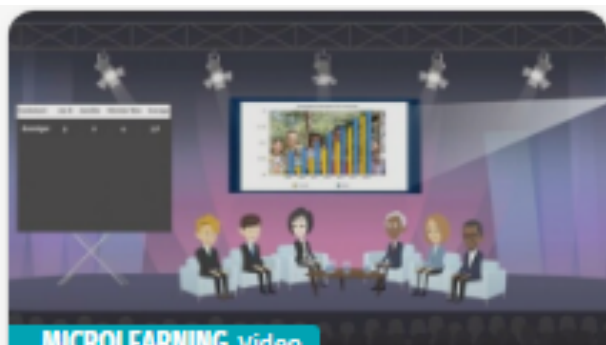

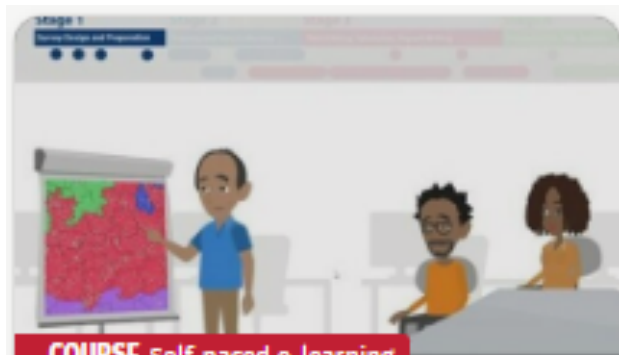

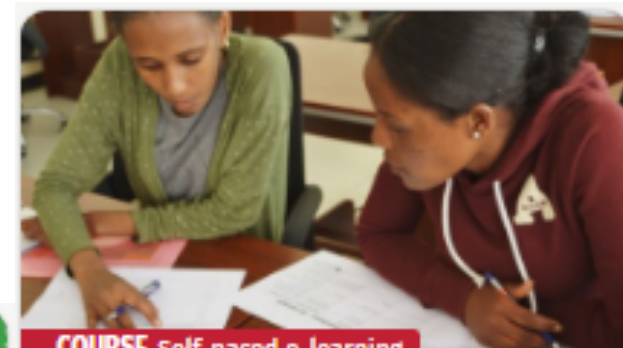
