

Role of UNITAR in the GMP2

- Component 1: Securing conditions for successful project implementation
- Component 2: Capacity building and data generation on analysis of core abiotic matrices (air and water)
- Component 3: Capacity building and data generation on analysis of core biotic matrices (human milk)
- Component 4: Assessment of existing capacities and reinforcement of national POPs monitoring
- Component 5: Securing conditions for sustainable POPs monitoring



























Role of UNITAR in the GMP2 (2)

UNITAR's role

- Provide technical and administrative support to UNEP
- Establish the organization of the prossesses

Scope: GMP2 Africa, Asia and Pacific + GMP2 GRULAC (BCCC as EA)

Timeline: first year of the GMP2 projects

Purpose

To ensure a smooth and timely start of the projects





























Role of UNITAR in the GMP2 (3)

- 1. Organize/participate in regional inception workshops
 - → materials and presentations; expert advice
- 2. Assist in the actualization of the POPs laboratory databank
 - → consultant's ToR; questionnaires; expert advice
- 3. Assist expert labs in the planning of their training activities
- 4. Prepare templates for reporting of air/water sampling
- 5. Prepare templates for reporting of analytical results
- 6. Develop an interactive web-based platform for information exchange for countries to report progress; and provide expert advice on the platform
